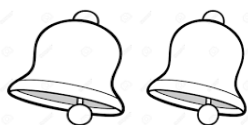

Ten days of mourning have passed and our books of commemoration (in each of our seven churches) are now closed. The past has gone and the future is before us. We pray for our new King.

Time is like that isn't it? It is unstoppable and inevitably has its own way. As Isaac Watts wrote...
"Time, like an ever-rolling stream, bears all its sons away; They fly, forgotten, as a dream dies at the opening day."

It's pointless fighting against time, we have to learn to roll with it. Time is a precious gift to us. In 2002, Her Majesty said, "I know just how much I rely on my faith to guide me through the good times and the bad. Each day is a new beginning. I know that the only way to live my life is to try to do what is right, to take the long view, to give of my best in all that the day brings, and to put my trust in God... I draw strength from the message of hope in the Christian gospel."

This speaks to me of a person who wanted to make the most of her time and use it wisely. Faith was a central tenet of the Queen's life, and perhaps sensing the eternal was a key to unlocking the limitations of the temporal.

Whatever you feel you can do is welcome, whether it is driving, committee work, befriending or other small tasks. Most Volunteers are drivers or coordinators who are provided with a telephone when on duty. Drivers can claim for petrol used and other expenses and have to undergo DBS security checks to ensure they have no previous convictions for driving or other offences, which may preclude them from working with vulnerable people. We will take you to medical and dental appointments, to visit friends at home or in hospital. We can help with taking you to shops, local clubs and groups or any activity to help combat loneliness. Or we can just call in for a chat and a cup of tea.

Fittleton cum Haxton Parish Council Meeting

The meeting of Fittleton cum Haxton Parish Council met on 6 September at Phoenix Hall. No members of the public attended. Our Wiltshire councillor, Ian Blair Pilling attended and spoke about the next Stonehenge Area Board Meeting that will be held at Phoenix Hall on 22 September. He updated the meeting on the forthcoming Community Governance Review and explained the context of the issues to be discussed. Finally, he spoke about the forthcoming challenges of the cost-of-living challenges and explained that Wiltshire Council is awaiting guidance from the government. Meanwhile the parish councils of the Avon Valley area have agreed to meet to review contingency plans for assisting residents to navigate the challenges.

The parish council has received notification of the state of the bells of Fittleton All Saints Church and a request for support to repair them. Councillors unanimously agreed to a donation towards the repair costs.

The parish Council is currently advertising for a Parish Clerk. Full training will be given to the successful applicant. The job is 4 hours per week, based at home and includes minute taking at the meetings that take place 6 times per year on Tuesday evenings. Applications should be made to chairfittletonhaxton@gmail.com. The next meeting of the parish council is on **8 November, 7:30pm at Phoenix Hall**. The public is invited to attend.



PHILIP WILKINSON – POLICE AND CRIME COMMISSIONER

I've now been 'in the job' of PCC for a year, and if there is one thing that's been made abundantly clear to me, it's that your confidence in policing is not where I want it to be.

Whilst there are clearly some exceptional individual officers, overall, there have been gaps in the service you receive. In the past year, I have made practical steps to address them, such as the purchasing of effective technology such as drones and ensuring more officers are deployed to the rural crime team.

The damage done by crimes such as hare coursing, criminal damage and theft have a massive impact on the rural community and history shows that at times of recession, farms become targets.

I regularly speak to farmers and I'm all too aware of the reasons why you feel that reporting crime is not worthwhile. In my Police and Crime Plan, I've committed to ensure Wiltshire Police takes these crimes seriously and deals with them effectively.

This is why I've taken steps to ensure the rural crime team has the capabilities and staffing it needs.

As part of this commitment, Wiltshire Police has introduced online crime reporting specifically for rural crime. The form takes about ten minutes and is picked up by the same people who answer 101 calls.

It's vital that to build up an overall picture and identify patterns of criminal activity, all crime is reported, no matter how small it may seem.

As this has only recently been introduced, I welcome your feedback about how the system is working. It's only through working together that we can stop these crimes from happening and make Wiltshire a safer place to live and work. <https://bit.ly/reportruralcrim>

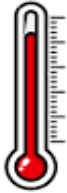

ENERGY SAVING TIPS



30 DEGREE WASH

Setting your machine to a cooler wash saves a significant amount of energy so it pays to do this where possible



CHECK YOUR THERMOSTAT

Turn down your thermostat by one or two degrees and put on an extra layer of clothing which can save between £5 and £10 per month on your energy bill



DON'T OVER-FILL

Boiling a kettle half full instead of full four times a day can save enough energy to run a tv for four hours, so just boil what you need, instead of filling up the whole kettle



DEFROST FREEZERS

Keeping your fridge and freezer free of frost will boost their efficiency and use less energy. Keeping your fridge at least three quarters full will also mean it needs less energy to keep at the same temperature.



SWITCH OFF STANDBY

Leaving electrical devices on standby, such as TV's and microwaves, amounts to around 8% of the average electricity bill. This could save you £30 per person per year.



SWITCH TO LED

LED bulbs are more energy efficient than regular lightbulbs. This small change can be implemented gradually when your current bulbs reach end of life.
