There's something about Remembrance Sunday that reminds us just how unsafe the world can be. We recall the sacrifice of so many men and women over the years, who played their part in keeping us safe. Our way of life was preserved through them. Evil regimes, terrorist organisations, and fascist dictators have had to be confronted in order for us to live in safety.

Health and Safety legislation of course has quite a reputation and can often be the butt of our jokes. We associate it with over bureaucracy and litigation culture, but the simple truth is – being safe is a good thing. It's not to be taken lightly.

There is a scene in the Chronicles of Narnia, where Lucy asks Mr Beaver about Aslan. The Lion that represents Jesus in the story. Lucy says, "Is He Safe?" The response comes. "Oh no he's not safe, but He is good."

Holding on to a faith in God, means admitting our own vulnerability and trusting in God's goodness. It is God who is our refuge and our strength. He is the ever-present help in time of trouble.

Remembering sacrifice, honouring the fallen and for the first time in 70 years, singing "God save the King", is a solemn duty, but we gather in humility, praying for a safer world.

#### Every home burglary victim to get a police visit

Every burglary victim knows the impact is deeper than simply having your possessions taken.

Burglary violates a safe space and you expect the police to respond appropriately when you report it. Sadly, that expected police service when you are a home burglary victim has been severely lacking in recent years. This is consistent across the UK - not just in here in Wiltshire.

That is why I am pleased Wiltshire Police have now pledged to attend every home burglary. It's a leap in the right direction.

The force is already providing this in 88.7% of cases but this extra effort should help to increase victim satisfaction, preserve evidence sooner with increased prosecutions.

Residents tell me they want police officers to do the basics right: good, quality investigations which result in locking the bad people up, protect the vulnerable and care about victims.

Wiltshire Police's home burglary further action taken figures, where a suspect is identified, charged or cautioned, is currently at 3.9% on a rolling 12month average. This isn't good enough and I have been clear in letting our Chief Constable know this – and he agrees.

By improving how officers deal with home burglary victims should not only increase those figures but also, and more importantly, will positively impact on the public's confidence and trust in the policing service they receive.

I will be directly scrutinising this commitment and challenging them to show that effective, quality, investigations are taking place.

I have also senior officers to explore if it is operationally possible to extend this commitment to all non-dwelling burglaries, like rural outbuildings and sheds. As ever, this will be a delicate balance but aiming to provide the policing service our communities want is vital.
