NETHERAVON PARISH COUNCIL UPDATES

A345 SPEED REDUCTION TRIAL

On 30th October the speed limit on the A345 will be reduced to 40mph for a trial period of one year. The new signs signifying 40mph will be going up as soon as they are ready and we will be putting up 3 Speed Indicator Devices (SID) along the stretch from Stagg's Lane to Mill Road. We have also got a very keen Netheravon Speed Watch Group who have been trained and will be on duty at designated places to monitor speeds with a speed camera. The police have also agreed to be on duty with speed cameras on occasion. If it is proved that these measures make a difference and people noticeably drive within the 40mph speed limit the speed reduction will become permanent. Thank you to the Speedwatch team and especially the Team Leader for volunteering to give their time to make the A345 a safer road.

WILTSHIRE CONNECT - ON DEMAND BUS

Don't forget to use the Wiltshire Connect on demand bus. It is a bookable, on-demand service which operates between 6am-8pm Monday to Friday and 7am-7pm on Saturdays. Journeys can be booked up to a week ahead and on the day with 30 minutes notice, subject to vehicle availability. Download the app or call **01225 712900** between 9am-5pm Monday to Friday. If it is not used, we will lose this service.

ADULT EXERCISE EQUIPMENT IN MILLENNIUM PARK

It has been pointed out that this equipment is being underused. 

The Phoenix Hall offers a location for local people for all activities in the village. There is a main hall with a wonderful open space suitable for any activity. The hall has tables and chairs for 80+ with a full commercial kitchen.

There is a wealth of activities which happen weekly such as the hugely popular Cheerful Cuppa held every Tuesday from 10.00 to 12.00. This gives villagers the chance to meet up and have a hot drink with a slice of cake. The weekly friendly ART group welcomes all of any ability and runs on Tuesdays from 14.30 to 16.00. There are also a number of weekly fitness classes for all abilities.

The first Saturday of each month we have the Pop-Up market from 9.00 to 14.00 and The Friends of Netheravon School PTFA have Prize Bingo on the last Sunday of each month from 13.00 to 17.00. You may be considering starting a small group for crafting or perhaps a gardening club for weekly or occasional get-togethers. Our smaller comfortable committee room, which has its own small kitchen, is set up for meetings, but can be used for any small functions.

The hall is often used for a family celebration and looks very smart all dressed up. The front door and ramps give full disabled access.

The hall is available for one-off occasions If you want to visit the hall, just ask our booking clerk, Pam Perry, and she will organize someone to show you around at a convenient time.
