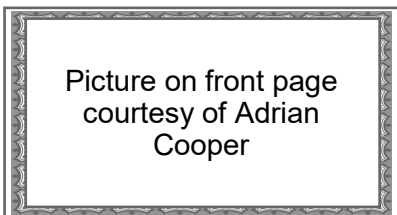

## A word from Rev Philip Bromiley, our Team Rector.



In touch with the past...

There was a woman who spent some months serving God in Kenya. On her final visit to a remote township she attended a medical clinic. As the Maasai women there began to sing together, she found herself deeply moved by their hauntingly beautiful harmonies. She wanted to always remember so she recorded this moment and would share it with friends when she arrived home. With tears flowing down her cheeks, she turned to her friend and asked, "Can you please tell me the translation of the words to this song?" Her friend looked at her and solemnly replied, "If you boil the water, you won't get dysentery."

The summer months are often preoccupied by special times: family holidays, exam results, weddings, anniversaries, new schools, universities... these are all milestones and life defining events that make us who we are. We shape our own history by them.

Being a Rector in the Church of England is quite humbling because, reminding by the list of predecessors on the wall, you can't escape the truth that we stand in a lineage, consistently connected to past generations: individuals whose lives have shaped us in so many ways.

All of our churches go back a long way! Durrington All Saints celebrates its 900th anniversary this year. Bulford St. Leonard's is completing some conservation work on its medieval wall drawings and memorials, and Netheravon All Saints is mentioned in the Domesday Book! Apparently, in 1086, it was "derelict and the roof so damaged that it is almost in ruin". I guess every generation has a responsibility to leave a positive legacy for the future.

What will our legacy be? How will history look on us? Did we do our bit to preserve the past? Did we leave it in a better state that when we found it? How best can we use the resources we have?

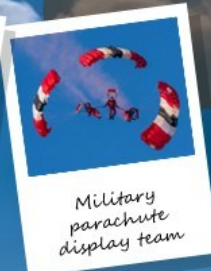

## **Netheravon Parish Council News from 3<sup>rd</sup> July meeting**

Cllr Mackay Chaired the meeting in the Chairmans absence and welcomed everyone to the meeting.

### **Police Report**

Report received and sent out before the meeting.

### **COMMITTEE REPORTS**

**Planning** – It was agreed to accept the updated Planning Committee regulations. We had received one application for a new House at Thorne Road: Council resolved to support the application with some comments; Parish Council has concerns about highway access, and the need to add a drop kerb for this property on Mill Road to satisfy the number of car park spaces required. Mill Road is already highly congested with parked cars, and the frequent bus service already has difficulty on this road passing these vehicles. A new drop kerb will remove 2 parking slots, and those cars have nowhere else convenient to park. That whole part of the village is very congested, adding more cars is not practical.

NPC request that WC Highways establishes that there will be visibility for those cars exiting Thorne Road to Mill Road, NPC has some doubts that this is achievable.

There is a concern that this property may be planned to be connected to the MOD sewerage system, which is already overloaded and sometimes backs up. NPC suggest it should connect to the Wessex Water sewage system to avoid further problems for existing householders.

Because of the nature of this residential road there needs to be a plan from the contractors as to when deliveries are made to site, the road cannot take 2-way traffic and HGV vehicles will block the road for residents.

**Cemetery /enhancement /Netheravon in bloom** – Judging for Netheravon in Bloom will be week commencing 21<sup>st</sup> July and will include tubs and allotments, which all look lovely.

**Recreation-** An amenities fund will need to be set up once the transfer of funds from Wiltshire Council comes through. We will also arrange a special meeting with the residents when it has all gone through.

**Allotments-** We have still got the Wexland Avenue allotment (s) available it was advertised in the Newsletter.

**Rights of way** Gate has been replaced between Downside and A345.

## Netheravon Parish Council

### **Phoenix Hall Chairmans report**

The total for last year was £14085 this means with 8 months to go we are already up on bookings by £988.38 for the full year. Expenditure will increase as we head towards the hall floor upgrade, and a new fire door to the committee room following the fire assessment.

### **Maintenance and Improvements**

Following the fire assessment, we have now purchased smoke detectors and a carbon monoxide monitor.

We still need to obtain a new fire extinguisher and signs.

We are also looking to get the lights in the toilets moved to sensor one to save electric.

### **Netheravon Speed Watch Group**

Still awaiting the official report, Councillor I Blair-Pilling to write to the cabinet meeting and emphasised that it is not something to worry about. Road safety meeting on the 4<sup>th</sup> of July was cancelled. It was agreed unanimously to close the speed watch bank account and transfer it to the Parish council, as we are losing money monthly on fees that the bank is now charging. Cllr Coslett to take forward.

**Netheravon Newsletter-** It was agreed to give the Newsletter the donation from the Parish Council now as funds are getting low.

## Fittleton cum Haxton Parish Council

An update on the latest news from our Parish and a couple of reminders.

The new 30 mph signs have been erected in Haxton. They serve as a prominent reminder that road users are entering the village with a 30 mph limit. As an aside it was found that the average speed of vehicles entering Haxton from Everleigh was 23.7mph and over 7 days a total of 3689 vehicles used this road.

The new fingerpost is now up on the C32/Everleigh Crossroads and looking great after our local 'man' spent many hours painting and trawling the internet for letters and screws! also a thanks to Julian from Haxton Farm who hauled the old one out with a telescopic handler saving a few hours of digging.

Finally a new street sign is on the way in the next couple of weeks for Downs View Close. Wiltshire Council only provide this service if Health & Safety is involved and review requests such as this on an annual basis. So it is self funded from the Parish precept.

Over the next few weeks our budget will take a number of 'hits' to the total of £2525, these are in addition to donations to selected local charities and the 'bills' that arrive on an annual basis such as insurance etc. Rest assured your money is spent wisely and in some cases not spent at all!

## KNOW HOW THE FRAUDSTERS WORK...

### A FRAUDSTER'S CALL TO YOU

#### Spot it and stop it!

A criminal contacts you, pretending to be a police officer or bank official. They claim there is an issue with your bank account, or request your assistance with an investigation.

They ask you to withdraw cash or foreign currency, provide your bank cards or PIN numbers, purchase high value items such as gold bullion, or hand over jewellery which will later be collected by a courier from your home.

**STOP FRAUD** POLICE OR BANK OFFICIALS WILL NEVER ASK FOR PIN NUMBERS, BANK CARDS, GOODS OR MONEY!

To make sure the caller is from the bank or really a police officer, hang up the phone at the start of the call and wait 5 minutes (criminals stay on your phone line) or use a different phone and call:

- 101** – to verify if the person is a police officer.
- 159** – to speak to your bank (or call the number on back of card).

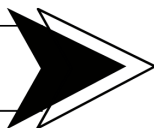
